### English

### The Prime Areas of Learning

During our Maths Sessions we will be looking at; consolidating our work on subitising, counting, sorting & matching, comparing & ordering, patterns, spatial reasoning, adding more, taking away, doubling, sharing, grouping and halving.

### Expressive Arts & Design

The children will create a piece of art using the skills, techniques of Jackson Pollock.

### Religious Education

During R.E. lessons children will cover the following topics; To the Ends of the Earth (Pentecost), Dialogue and Encounter (Communities, St Peter and St Paul) and Hinduism.

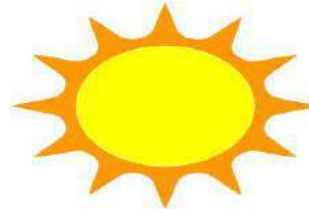
