



Religious Education

Our topics for this term will be To the Ends of the Earth and Dialogue and Encounter. In the first topic, we will learn about what happened after Jesus rose from the dead including the ascension and Pentecost. In the final topic of the year, we will be learning about a different faith.

Geography

The children will be learning about the five oceans and seven continents. The children will learn about where Trinidad is, its human and physical geography as well as comparing it to England.

History

The children will learn about the history of toys. Children will identify the very first toy invented as well as toys across different times, with a focus in comparing toys from living memory and beyond living memory.

English

In the Summer term, will be Coming to England by Floella Benjamin. We will be learning about the author as well as exploring her birth country of Trinidad. Also, we will be reading Traction Man and writing letters. We will be also reading and performing some seasons poems.

Mathematics

A big focus this term will be on reading and writing numbers up to 100. There will be lots of work on counting too. We will also be beginning early multiplication and division through grouping and sharing. We will start learning about simple fractions (halves and quarters.) We will be learning about the value of coins and notes and we will start to tell the time (O'clock and half past.)

Science

In Science, the children will be learning the names of common wild and garden plants. They will be learning how to label the parts of plants and trees. They will continue to observe how deciduous trees change throughout the seasons.

Later in the term, the children will learn about different types of animals and find out how to classify animals by what they eat.
