



## Topic

Our topic for the Summer term is 'The Seaside'. We will be learning all about the geography of seashores first of all, focussing on Blackpool. We will be looking at human and physical features of the UK including naming the surrounding seas and capital cities of each country. We will also be comparing the human and physical features of Leigh to those of Blackpool.

In the second half term, we are going to move on to the history of seaside towns as well as the Local History of our church and the school. We will study the history of Blackpool in particular the Victorians and looking at what changes have occurred with seashores within living memory and beyond living memory. We will be looking at the clothing people used to wear, the transportation used and the activities that took place.

## PSHE
