



Religious Education

Our first branch this term is Galilee to Jerusalem. The children will learn all about John the Baptist and the baptism of Jesus. They will learn our key words including temptation and sin, linking this to The Lords Prayer. The children will listen to a variety of scriptures from the bible and retell these in different ways. Our second branch will be Desert to garden. Throughout this branch, the children will learn about Jesus' miracles and all about Holy Week. The children will be encouraged to make links with prior learning and to ask wondering questions throughout each branch.

Science

In Science, the children will learn about animals including humans. We will explore the basic needs of animals for survival (water, food and air), the importance of exercise and how to look after their personal hygiene. We will also research how animals have offspring which grow into adults.

During the half term, the children will work scientifically by carrying out comparative tests and research.

Creative curriculum (Music and Art)

In music, the children will have the opportunity to express themselves through singing, playing the claves and glockenspiels. In art they will learn about tone and texture,

English

This term, the children will be enjoying a variety of books such as Meerkat Mail by Emily Gravett and The Day the Crayons Quit by Oliver Jeffers. The children will be writing a variety of different texts and learning how to answer a variety of questions based on different text types. They will also be creating their own weather forecast and a non-chronological report about the weather around the world.

We kindly ask parents and carers to support their child by reading with them each night. This develops reading, fluency and understanding skills that are so important at this age. Thank you for your continued support with this.

Mathematics

This term in maths, children will be learning how to add and subtract 2-digit numbers including when there is an exchange. They will become confident with their 5- and 10-times tables through lots of practise and games.

The children will be introduced to:

- 3D shapes – faces, edges & vertices
- Money – pounds, pence & change
- Measurement – length, height & mass
- Fractions – finding a third

Topic - Geography

Our Geography topic this term is 'Weird and Wonderful weather'. The children will name and locate countries in the UK before moving on to studying seasonal weather patterns. They will learn how to use weather-measuring equipment to monitor daily weather patterns before creating their own weather report.

The children will also learn about weather patterns around the world and will be able to locate the continents and equator on a world map. They will learn about wild weather such as tornadoes, thunderstorms and snow!
