



## Topic

This term will be starting our geography topic. The children will be learning about mountains, rivers and the water cycle. They will learn all about the formation of rivers and mountains. They will answer the question 'where does rain come from?' The children will become more familiar with maps and completing some problem solving using their geographical skills.

## English

This term the children will be producing a range of writing for a variety of purposes. They will be reading the fantastic Horrid Henry stories; they will write a playscript where they will have the opportunity to perform and write a new chapter for the popular series of books. Later in the term, the children will use their geographical knowledge to produce some non-fiction texts. We will also be reading the exciting story called 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons' by Andy Shepherd. We will also be performing some hilarious poems by Jack Ousby and Roald Dahl. The children will have the chance to write their own narrative poem too.

## Science

During Science lessons, we will be recapping the work on eating a balanced diet from Year 2 and we will be learning about skeletons and muscles including their names and how they work. Later in the term, we will be learning all about forces. We will investigate forces such as friction and gravity. We will also be researching a famous scientist, Isaac Newton.
