



Topic

This term will be starting our geography topic. We will start the topic by recapping our knowledge from Key Stage 1 about the UK and learning about the regions. We will compare the landscape of the North West compared to other regions. We will be look at different types of maps and atlases to investigate how the land in the UK has changed over time. We will take a trip on the Mersey Ferry whilst learning about rivers and coastlines.

English

This term the children will be producing a range of writing for a variety of purposes. We will start the term by reading the book, The Three little wolves and the big bad pig, then writing a persuasive letter as one of the characters. They will be reading the fantastic Horrid Henry stories; they will write a playscript where they will have the opportunity to perform and write a new chapter for the popular series of books. We will also be reading the exciting story by Andy Shepherd called 'The Boy Who Grew Dragons.

Science

During Science lessons, we will be recapping the work on eating a balanced diet from Year 2. We will be learning about skeletons and muscles including their names and how they work. Later in the term, we will be learning all about forces. We will investigate forces such as friction and gravity during British Science Week. We will also be researching a famous scientist, Isaac Newton.

Mathematics

During the Spring term, the children will be continuing to practise using the column method for addition and subtraction.
