



Religious Education

We will focus our learning on our topic 'Galilee to Jerusalem' where we will be learning about some of the miracles in the Bible, the sacrament on reconciliation and the sacrament of the sick. In the second half term, our topic is 'Desert to Garden' where we will learn about how Jesus brings new life, hope and growth, and how we as Christians are called to grow in faith and love.

English

We will be reading 'Who Let the Gods Out' by Maz Evans in the first half term, basing our writing on a non-chronological report on Zodiac signs and a narrative focussing on a setting description. In the second half term we will be reading 'The Firework Makers Daughter' and writing diary entries and our own portal story. We will also be looking at the poem 'Mr Mistoffelees' by T S Eliot before writing a poem of our own.

We will also be focusing on complex sentences by adding fronted adverbials and conjunctions.

Science

Our focus for this half term will be electricity. As part of this topic, we will be learning how to make simple series circuits using lots of electrical components, including switches. We will also explore different conductors and insulators and how these affect the electrical current.

In the second half term, we will be looking at living things and their habitats. Through this topic, children will group living things using diagrams and keys and we will also study and compare vertebrates and invertebrates.

We will be working scientifically by planning investigations, asking scientific questions and making predictions about our results.

Computing and PSHE

In this term, children will have the opportunity to create their own podcast. We are going to link this to safer internet day and Children's Mental Health week which will both take place during this term.

Mathematics

Multiplication and division will be the main focus this first half term. The children will be introduced to the remaining times tables including 6s, 7s, 9s, 11s and 12s whilst continuing to practise all previously taught times tables. We will then move onto formal written methods of multiplication and division including multiplying and dividing up to three-digit numbers.

We will also be recapping addition and subtraction using the column method before revisiting fractions and decimals to consolidate and further our knowledge in this area

Physical Education

This term, PE is on Mondays where children will be developing their skills in dance and football.

History

The history topic for this term is the Romans and the impact they had on the British Empire. We will learn about how the Roman army invaded led by Julius Caesar and then Emperor Claudius. We will find out what changes the Romans brought to Britain and how some tribes rebelled against Roman rule. We will also be taking a trip to Chester to take part in a Roman soldier workshop and Chester tour.

Geography

In Geography we will be learning about the European area of Naples. We will also be studying volcanoes and earthquakes and why they happen in this area.
