Mathematics

In the early stages of the Summer Term, the children will continue to practice their arithmetic skills. We will also be applying our learning to different reasoning and problem-solving contexts. Following the completion of SATs, the children will apply their knowledge of Maths to different real-life concepts through their Science and D&T sessions.

Science

In our new Science topic, we will be learning more about the Human Body. During this topic, the children will study the cardiovascular system and the key components it contains. Alongside this, the children will learn how different stimuli can impact the way it works and how to take care of their body.

Religious Education

The first RE topic is Healing. During this topic, the children will learn about the Sacrament of the Sick and how Jesus cared for those who were ill both physically and spiritually.
