



Topic

Mathematics

Throughout the course of the Spring Term, the children will continue to practice their arithmetic skills. However, the main focus of the term will be around statistics, geometry and measurements. We will also be applying our learning to different reasoning and problem-solving contexts.

Science

In our new Science topic, we will be looking at how electricity works. The children will use this learning to produce their own electrical circuits. In the second part of the term, Year 6 will be studying light. During this topic, the children will be discussing what light is and will be completing investigations to learn how it can be used.

Religious Education

The first RE topic is Sources. During this topic, the children will learn about their local church and the wider Christian community. The second topic is unity which focuses on the Eucharist. During this topic, the children will learn more about the sacrament and its significance to Christians. The topic before Easter focuses on New Life and the Resurrection.
