**Correos** – a Post office




**Una farmacia** – a pharmacy

## Indicaciones (Directions)

### DIRECTIONS (directions)



**A la derecha** – on the right  
**A la izquierda** – on the left  
**Todo recto** – straight on

**Aquí está** – There it is  
**¿Dónde está...? – Where is...?**



**Perdone** – Excuse me  
**Estoy perdido/a** – I'm lost  
**¿Dónde está...? – Where is...?**  
**Gracias** – Thank you

## Grammar

Determiners	Masculine singular	Feminine singular	Plural
<b>a / some ...</b> examples	<b>un</b> un bolí (a pen)	<b>una</b> una goma (a rubber)	<b>Unos/unas</b> unas tijeras (scissors)

❖ **Word order** in Spanish is often different to English:

**Una tienda de música**      A music shop  
**Un diccionario de español**      A Spanish dictionary

❖ Describing something in the **negative form**:

✓ When you say that you **do not have something** or **there is not something**, you need to add '**no**' before the verb and **miss out the determiner** in front of the noun:

**Tengo un libro.** I have a book.  
**No tengo libro.** I do not have a book.  
**Hay una farmacia.** There is a pharmacy.  
**No hay farmacia.** There is no pharmacy.
