## Grammar

### Using conjunctions in Spanish:

Use more complex language by using conjunctions:

**y** = and

**pero** = but

**porque** = because

### Expressing an opinion in Spanish:

When we express an opinion about a noun in Spanish, the noun is always preceded by a determiner (in the context of subjects, the definite article el/la/los/las)

Me encanta **la música**. (I love Music.)



No me gusta **el deporte**. (I don't like PE.)



**WATCH OUT!**  
You need to add a 'n' at the end of **me gusta / no me gusta / me encanta** if it is followed by a plural noun or more than one thing:  
Me **gustan** las ciencias.  
I like Science.
