Grammar

When you ask a question in Spanish you can turn a sentence into a question by raising the pitch of your voice at the end of the question. Practice reading these phrases!

- **Hoy es lunes.** – Today is Monday.
- **¿Hoy es lunes?** – Is it Monday today?
