### Noun Bank: Family

**el papá** -the dad  
**el hermano** – the brother  
**el bebé** – the baby  
**el abuelo** – the granddad

**la mamá** - the mum  
**la hermana** – the sister  
**la abuela**- the grandma

**Soy...** - I am ....

### Noun Bank : Face parts

**el pelo** - the hair  
**la nariz** – the nose  
**la boca** - the mouth  
**la cabeza** - the head

**los ojos** – the eyes

**las orejas** - the ears

**Tengo...** – I have ...  
**No tengo...** - I don't have any...

### Grammar

There are two words for “the” in Spanish for singular nouns.  
These words are “**el**” and “**la**”.

### Grammar

There are also two words for “the” in Spanish for plural nouns: “**los**” and “**las**”.

### Grammar

In Spanish, when you use a **number** in front of a noun, the number **replaces** the determiner “**los**” or “**las**”:

<b>los</b> ojos = <b>the</b> eyes	<b>las</b> orejas = <b>the</b> ears
<b>dos</b> ojos = <b>two</b> eyes	<b>dos</b> orejas = <b>two</b> ears

### Fact Bank

In Spain, some children call their grandparents “abu”.  
If the baby is a boy, you say “el bebé”, and if the baby is a girl, you say “la bebé”.

“ja” (oreja)  
“jo” (ojo)
