CAFOD Fundraising



We have received a thank you from CAFOD volunteers for all your support with this fundraising.

Once again I must highlight what parents should do if their child develops any of the following symptoms

- New continuous cough and/or
- High temperature
- A loss of, or change in normal sense of taste or smell

If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, you should arrange for a them to be tested immediately

Whilst waiting for the test result, all other members of the household should stay at home and self-isolate.

If the test result is positive, all other household members must stay at home and not leave the house for 10 days from the day when the first person in the house became ill.

If the test result is positive, your child will be required to self-isolate for a period of 10 days from the day that their symptoms started.

If your child's test result is negative, anyone in your household who is isolating solely because of your child's symptoms can stop isolating.

Household members staying at home for 10 days will greatly reduce the overall amount of infection the household could pass on to others in the community.
