



XII Apostles Remote Learning Home School Agreement September 2020

School

The school will provide quality remote learning that ensures there is as little disruption to the children's learning as possible. They will do this by:

- *planning a series of sessions in all curriculum subjects.
- *assessing children's understanding so that future sessions can be adapted.
- * setting work Class Dojo portfolio or Purple Mash.
- *having high expectations for the work submitted.
- *provide feedback to children on it's content and quality.
- *signpost parents to government approved remote learning resources from Oak Academy, BBC Bite Size etc
- *modelling new concepts to the children using pre-recorded sessions live sessions
- *proving at least one live check in session per week
- *monitoring the children's engagement in remote learning and keep a record of those children who do not engage.
- *contacting parents who may be experiencing challenges in engaging their child via Class Dojo or phone to offer advice and support.

Live Sessions

- *Teachers will give at least 24 hours notice for live sessions and ensure notice is given for any basic resources that may be required.
- *Teachers will post a link to the live session on Class Dojo or via email.
- *Teachers will ensure that the sessions are no longer than 1 hour.
- *Teachers will announce their intention to record the session at the beginning to allow parents/ carers the opportunity to switch off cameras and microphones.
- *Teachers will make clear their expectations at the beginning of the session this will include the behaviour expectations of being Ready, Respectful and Safe.

Parent/ Carer

To support school in the event of remote learning, I agree that:

- *I will ensure my child is available to learn remotely everyday.
- * I will ensure that work set is completed on time and to the best of my child's ability.
- * I will report any technical issues to the school as soon as possible.
- * I will inform school if my child does not have access to remote learning material and request support.
- * I will inform school immediately if my child becomes symptomatic or test positive with COVID 19.
- * I will monitor my child's safe use of technology and the internet.
- * I will ensure my child uses the equipment and technology used for remote learning as intended.
- * I understand that the work set during remote learning will not be repeated in school.

Live Sessions

- *I will be mindful about what family activities would potentially be heard/seen during the children's use of video conferencing.
- * I will ensure my child attends the session somewhere near enough so I can monitor, yet quiet enough to concentrate on their work.
- *I will ensure that my child dresses appropriately when video conferencing and make sure that there are no distracting materials e.g. phone, toys, television computer games.
- *I will support my child in engaging in the session appropriately.
- * I will ensure my child has some basic equipment ready e.g. paper and pencil ready.
- * I will ensure my child does not eat or drink during the session.
- *I agree that live sessions will be recorded but recordings will not be publicly available, only shared within Class dojo.
- *I am aware that teachers will announce that they will record the session so that my camera and microphone can turned off.
- *I will not take photos, screenshots, record any video, or audio, from these conference sessions. I understand that I do not have permission to do so.

Children

When I am working remotely I will:

- *engage in home learning and follow the school rules of being Ready, Respectful and Safe
- *be available to learn remotely during the school day and complete schoolwork on time and to the best of my ability.
- *report any technical issues to my teacher as soon as possible.
- *tell a responsible adult if I am feeling unwell or are unable to complete the schoolwork I have been set.
- *ensure they use any equipment and internet for remote learning responsibly.
- *follow e-safety rules covered in school and tell a responsible adult if I see anything that upsets me.

Live Sessions

During Live sessions I will:

- *be mindful about what family activities would potentially be heard/seen during the video conferencing.
- *attend the sessions in a place where I can be monitored but is quiet enough to concentrate on my work.
- *dress appropriately during the video conferencing session.
- *ensure that there are no distractions such as phones, toys, television or computer games during the session.
- *not eat or drink during the session.
- *engage in the live session and follow the school rules of being Ready, Respectful and Safe.
- *not distract other children during the session.
- *not take any photos or recordings of the live sessions because I do not have permission to do so.
